

- ◆ According to the Education Bureau's regulations for the "Secondary One Discretionary Places Scheme," each student may only apply to no more than two secondary schools; otherwise, their application eligibility will be cancelled.
- ◆ Our school has a total of 51 discretionary places, but the final number is subject to the Education Bureau's approval.
- ◆ Please make a copy of the completed form for your records.
- ◆ No primary school recommendation letter is required.
- ◆ If your child is included in our school's Successful List for Secondary One Discretionary Places, we will notify parents in writing and by phone on March 31, and parents are not required to respond to this notification.
